The Perimeter Research Assistantship program is for students in any pathway at Perimeter College of Georgia State University, with interest in pursuing Master's degrees, PhD's, JD's, or MD's. The program provides funding for part-time research on the Atlanta Campus with a faculty mentor in summer 2023. Applicants should be planning to transition from a Perimeter Campus to the Atlanta Campus within the next academic year.

Tentative summer schedule: late May through early August

QUALIFICATIONS

- Perimeter College students in any pathway or major, who are interested in pursuing the PhD, JD, MD, and MS.
- Expected graduation with a bachelor's degree between 2026 and 2028.
- International students, U.S. citizens, non-citizen nationals, and permanent residents.
- Applicants must be interested, motivated, and prepared to join a research project by a faculty member on the Atlanta Campus, although prior research experience is not required.
- Individuals from demographic groups underrepresented in the U.S. workforce are especially encouraged to apply (including those who identify as African American/African descent/Black, Hispanic/Latino/Latina, Pacific Islander, Native Hawaiian, or Native Alaskan, individuals with documented disabilities, students receiving Pell Grant financial aid, and/or first-generation college-bound students).
- All applicants must be hard-working, collaborative, persistent, and curious, with high attention to detail and good time management skills.
